
Dear Ms. Marshall:

The Court today entered the following order in the above-entitled case:

The motion of petitioner for leave to proceed *in forma pauperis* and the petition for a writ of certiorari are granted. The judgment is vacated and the case is remanded to the Court of Appeal of California, Second Appellate District, for further consideration in light of *Melendez-Diaz v. Massachusetts*, 557 U.S. \_\_\_\_ (2009).
